Bagistan is the hill of Jove (Atit 8pos), according to Diodorus (it 13, Â§ 1). It seems to mean really the place of Qod. We may thus compare the name with the Bethel of the Hebrews. The tablet and inscriptions of Darius, which have made Behistun famous in modern times, are in a recess to the right of the scarped face of the rock, and at a considerable elevation. (Ker Porter, vol. ii. p. 154.) Behistun and Kermanshah, inscribed upon the mountain, which already bore the impress of the great monarchs of Assyria and Persia, a record of his recent victory.² The name of Adrapan occurs only in Isidore,⁸ who places it between Bagistan and Ecbatana, at the distance of twelve schoeni--36 Roman or 34 British miles from the latter. It was, he says, the site of an ancient palace belonging to Ecbatana, which Tigranes the Armenian had destroyed. The name and situation sufficiently identify Adrapan with the modern village of Arteman,⁴ which lies on the southern face of Elwend near its base, and is well adapted for a royal residence.
